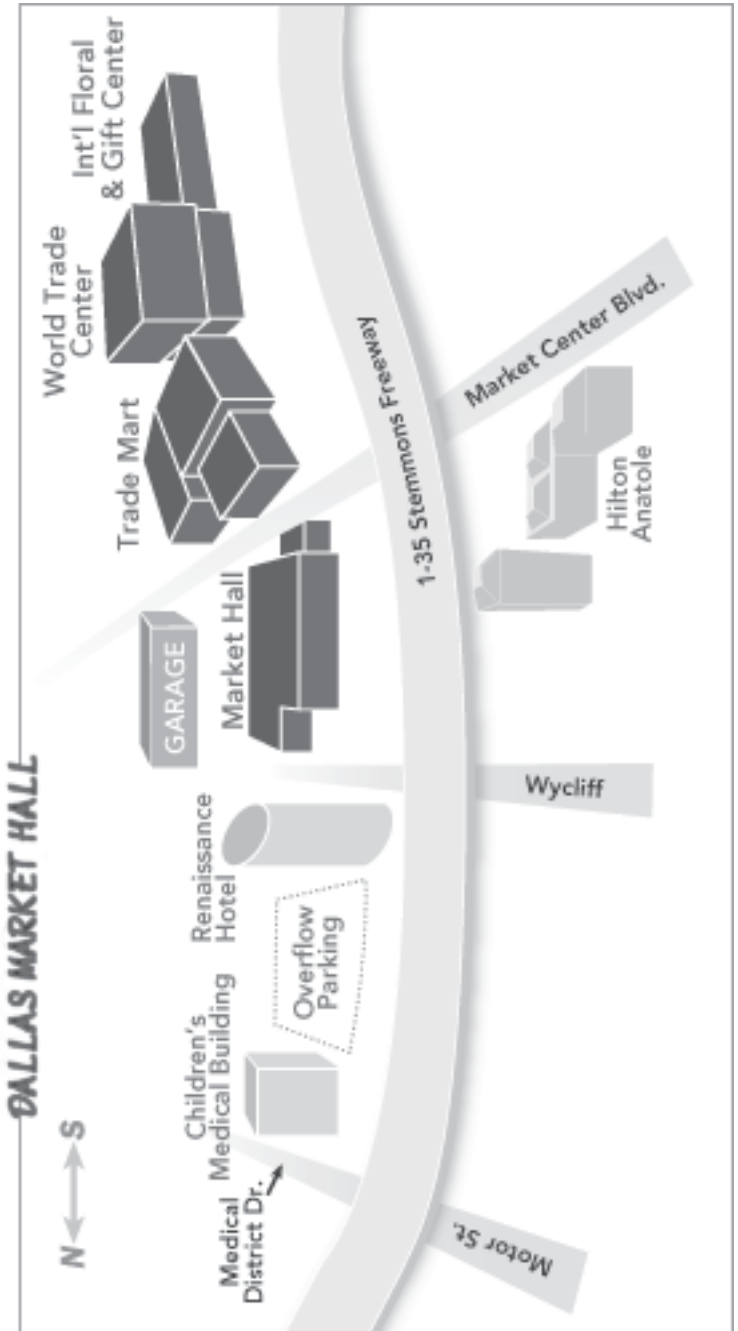

DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES

30% of total entry fees will be retained by the club for expenses. The remaining 70% will be divided as follows: Best in Sweepstakes - 25%; Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Sweepstakes - 15%; First in Each Class - 5%. This applies to both Sweepstakes and Veteran Sweepstakes.

NOTE: Chapter 11, Section 8, *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows* provides that castrated males may be entered in the Veteran Dog Class(s) and spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Bitch Class(s) at independent specialties only.

RV Parking Reservation Rules

Lone Star State Classic

Reservations Close Wednesday, November 18, 2009

- * You must make a reservation and be on the list to be allowed a parking space in the overnight RV parking lot.
- * Reserved overnight parking spaces are limited and are available on a first-come, first serve basis. When reserved space limit has been reached, additional reservations will be returned, so please make your reservation early!
- * No hook-ups will be provided for recreational vehicles. Absolutely no cones allowed in the parking areas.
- * Reservations must be received no later than Close of Entries Wednesday, December 18, 2009. Monies will not be refunded and reservations cannot be changed after closing.
- * Check must accompany reservation form (no credit cards).
- * **Do not include RV Parking Reservation form and payment with Entries. You MAY send RV Parking Reservation form and Reserved Grooming Reservation form together.**
- * Reservations are for 4 days, no partial reservations are accepted.
- * Absolutely no dumping of holding tanks on the grounds. Any unit suspected of a gray water or sewage leakage will be asked to leave the parking lot. Service will be available in the RV lot for emptying of tanks on Friday afternoon, December 4th. Owner must be present & pay service directly in cash. Put a sign in your window that says "Dump Service Please" so that the service will know to stop.
- * No fax, email, walk-ins or telephone reservations can be accepted.
- * All RV units must have a working fire extinguisher & generator exhaust piping.
- * Dogs are not allowed in the landscape area around Dallas Market Hall, or in the lawn or shrubs around the complex. Failure to observe the rules may result in an Event hearing. Outdoor exercise pens will be provided.
- * Everyone using this facility is expected to keep & leave the area clean.
- * All vehicles must be removed from the facility immediately following Best in Show on Sunday, December 6, 2009.

This will allow you to unload dogs at your leisure, when the building is fully air-conditioned. For exhibitors who do not show until Saturday, you can save on hotels bills and still be assured of having a space. Reservations close on **Wednesday, November 18, 2009**. SITE AVAILABILITY:

1. Exhibitors with and without grooming space reservations can drive in to unload from 10:30 am to 3:30 pm on Wednesday, December 2, 2009. All vehicles must be removed by 3:30 pm Wednesday. Unloading after 3:30 pm will be done from the loading dock area.
2. All engines and generators must be turned off during unloading and loading
3. The building will be locked at 11:00 pm and opened at 6:00 am all four days of the event for exhibitors.
4. Exhibitors are required to unload and remove their vehicles as quickly as possible. You can set up your equipment after your vehicle is removed.
5. All dogs and equipment must be removed immediately following BIS on Sunday, December 6, 2009.
6. The building is fully air conditioned except during hours of vehicle access. Please plan accordingly.

ACCESS and PARKING:

1. All loading and unloading must be done through the Loading Doors in the North Hall. No crates, dollies, pens, or other equipment can be transported through other doors or entrances to the building. Valet parking will be available Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
2. Absolutely no cones allowed in parking areas.
3. **We have space for a limited number of motor homes to park in the lot adjacent to the building. Use the mail-in Reserved Overnight RV Parking form in this premium list (page 14) to reserve your space. You will be put on the list for your space if you make a reservation - if your name does not appear on the list, you will not be allowed to park in the lot. You must enclose a stamped, self addressed envelope for confirmation of your reservation.**
4. No reservation of parking space by cones or other means.
5. Absolutely no dumping of holding tanks on the grounds. Any unit suspected of gray water or sewage leakage will be asked to leave the parking lot.
6. All vehicles must be removed from the facility immediately following Best in Show on Sunday, December 6, 2009.
7. During the show, all exhibitors will enter the property through the North Hall doors where the main grooming area is located. The Spectator entrance will be at the North Entrance to the Main Hall where the ticket booth is located.

2. Please stack hard-sided crates. Soft sided crates will be allowed in the building, BUT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE LEFT WITH A DOG IN THEM UNSUPERVISED OR OVERNIGHT. **ANY VIOLATION IS SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE.** Soft-sided crates are not allowed to be stacked.
3. The Show Committee will mark all crating and grooming space. Only approved crating and grooming space may be used. **ROPING OFF OR OTHERWISE RESERVING UNUSED CRATING and GROOMING SPACE IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.**
4. The Show Committee reserves the right to require the stacking of crates, limiting the use of exercise pens and any other remedies it may deem necessary for space in non-reserved spaces on a case by case basis at their discretion.
5. The Show Committees reserve the right to remove exercise pens anywhere in or around the building. **THERE WILL BE NO EXERCISE PENS ALLOWED IN NON-RESERVED GROOMING.** There will be space provided somewhere in the building for private exercise pens for those in non reserved grooming with a limit of 2 ex-pens per set-up. Ex-pens must be labeled and kept clean. Sawdust must be used in the pens and changed daily. Sawdust will be provided for a fee by the Lone Star State Classic if you have forgotten to bring your own.
6. **POSITVELY NO EXERCISING WILL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE THE BUILDING EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED AREAS.** Dogs are not allowed in the landscape area around Dallas Market Hall, or in the lawn or shrubs around the complex. Failure to observe the rules may result in an Event Hearing. Outdoor exercise pens will be provided.
7. No rugs or mats allowed in non-reserved grooming areas. **NO PLASTIC ALLOWED ON FLOORS UNDER EXERCISE PENS.** Please use sawdust in pens and change daily. **NO ELECTRICAL CORDS ALLOWED IN THE AISLES.** No sod allowed in the building.
8. Each exhibitor is responsible for cleaning his set-up each day. **REMEMBER TO BRING A BROOM.**
9. Public exercise pens will be provided and must be attended by owner or handler while in use.

DAY CRATING:

Space will be provided for exhibitors who want to “Show and Go”. Crates and grooming tables will be allowed. No exercise pens or drop pens in Day Crating. Everything must be removed immediately following Best in Show judging each day or the Show Committee will remove and discard same.

BUILDING RULES

1. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE ALLOWED TO BE BROUGHT INTO THE

EXTENSION CORD REQUIREMENTS

If extension cords are used, Ground Fault Circuit Interrupt Protection (GFCI) is required. This cord is sold at most building or electrical supply stores. These cords are easily recognized as they have a test and a reset button on the cord. Most of these cords have the words "GFCI protected" printed on the cord.

All 120-volt extension cords shall be three wire grounding type cords (recognized by the three prong plug on the end of the cord). Frayed or damaged cords may not be used. Extension cords may not be placed through doorways or across aisles.

These requirements will help eliminate harmful or fatal electrical hazards to you and/or your animals. City staff, including Fire Inspectors will check the premises from time to time for your compliance. Your cooperation is appreciated.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of

Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned check from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
